School Years	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Occupational Therapy</li> <li>• Physiotherapy</li> <li>• Social Work</li> <li>• Therapeutic Recreation</li> </ul>	Children and youth from 5-18 years of age, living in Guelph-Wellington County or Region of Waterloo, demonstrating a developmental delay or a physical disability *3
Technical Resources	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Augmentative communication – expanded level clinic</li> <li>• Seating &amp; mobility</li> </ul>	<p>Children from birth to 18 years of age, living in Guelph-Wellington County or Region of Waterloo, who require alternative or augmentative communication for speaking or writing</p> <p>Children from birth to 18 years of age, living in Guelph-Wellington County or Region of Waterloo, who require a seating device or wheelchair</p>
Autism Intervention	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Intensive behavioural intervention</li> <li>• Social work</li> </ul>	Children from 2-18 years of age living in Guelph-Wellington County or Region of Waterloo, with autism spectrum disorder (moderate to severe).
Infant Hearing	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Hearing screening</li> <li>• Auditory verbal therapy</li> <li>• Social work</li> </ul>	Children from birth to school entry age, living in Guelph-Wellington County or Region of Waterloo, who are deaf or hard of hearing
Blind Low Vision	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Social work</li> </ul>	Children from birth to school entry age, living in Guelph-Wellington County or Region of Waterloo, with blindness or low vision
Medical Clinics	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Orthopaedics</li> <li>• Orthotics</li> </ul>	Children living in Guelph-Wellington County or Region of Waterloo by therapist referral

Exceptions:

\*2 in Guelph-Wellington, does not include children and youth with communication delays or disabilities

\*3 in Region of Waterloo, school years services does not include children and youth with developmental delays **without** a physical disability
