You must be a Graduate of an accredited program in Physiotherapy; registration with the College of Physiotherapists of Ontario; proven ability and willingness to work as an integral member of a team, excellent oral and written communication skills; computer skills and strong time management skills. Ability to work independently with little direction, self-motivated and demonstrate initiative. Experience with children who have a variety of developmental, physical and communicative disorders.
