1.0 FTE Clinical Manager – OT School Based Rehabilitation Services

The Clinical Manager OT (CM) supervises, coaches and evaluates Occupational Therapy (OT) staff in their implementation of the work; supports the implementation of Practice for Change (P4C) which will involve both program design and supervision of staff focused on client and family centred care. The CM OT will supervise OT staff working in the School Based Rehabilitation Services program. The goal of this role is to ensure clinical consistency and best practices amongst OTs in this program while also working on the implementation of P4C. The assignment will work across multiple sites and virtually.

General Responsibilities:

You will provide input and assistance in all phases of service delivery including quality outcomes, and staff and client satisfaction. The scope of leadership is at both the program and clinical level. Your primary duties will be:

- Recruiting, training, orientation and supervision of assigned staff including staff scheduling, and health and safety.
- Provide staff supervision in a manner that creates opportunities for engagement and skill development
- Developing a high performing team
- Program development and implementation of P4C in Occupational Therapy in SBRS
- Performance management of staff through caseload review and chart audits.
- Promote and foster accountability in day to day operations including service standards
- Ensures client service delivery meets KidsAbility's strategic goals, objectives and service standards
- Participates in internal and external meetings, projects and committees
- Fosters positive working relationships in line with KidsAbility values with staff, peers, clients, families, volunteers and community

General Qualifications:

- Graduate of an accredited program in Occupational Therapy; registration with the College of Occupational Therapists of Ontario (COTO)

- Experience in P4C supervision and implementation required.
- clinical or management experience in a paediatric rehabilitation setting an asset
- a minimum of five years of experience delivering quality programs at KidsAbility or similar type of setting
- ability to integrate the Life Needs Model and sound clinical theory and practice into the program
- an ability to develop and lead teams; able to coordinate and schedule staff and program resources to identified needs and targets
- strategic planning skills; demonstrated customer service skills; solution focused coaching skills; and strong interpersonal and communication skills.
